- ▶ This is the first time Nature Connects has appeared in the Los Angeles area.
- ▶ The exhibition has been featured at select arboreta and botanic gardens around the country, but a number of displays have changed over time.
- ▶ Artist Sean Kenney, the world's first LEGO Certified Professional, used 464,770 LEGO bricks to create the 15 larger-than-life, nature-themed displays
- ▶ Kenney and his team spent more than 4,170 hours (173 days!) building the pieces in the exhibit. Visitors will also have the opportunity to play with 30,000 LEGO bricks on hand at the Garden throughout the exhibit's run.
- ▶ Tallest sculpture: Hummingbird (72")
- ▶ Longest sculpture: Dragonfly (48")
- ▶ Heaviest Sculpture: Bison (626 lbs)
